Sector San Francisco Incident Management Division Auxiliary Abandoned & Derelict Vessel Assessment Form

Abandoned Vessel: Any craft designed for navigation that has been moored, stranded, wrecked, sunk, or left unattended for longer than 45 days. (USCG, October 2011 Commandant Instruction 16465.5)

Derelict Vessel: A vessel *with an identifiable owner* that has been left unattended and is in significant disrepair, such that may affect the seaworthiness of the vessel or affect the safety of the public or the environment.

Marine Debris: Defined as any persistent solid material that is manufactured or processed and directly or indirectly, intentionally or unintentionally, disposed of or abandoned into the marine environment. (33CFR151.3000 (a))
