Process for Patrol Order Authorization with Sector SF

The process established earlier this year has been working fine with no noted problems. Each week, the Sector Response Department Head is provided with a listing of all AUX patrols for his concurrence. The only issue that has arisen is that some patrols are not input into POMS in time for the one week out review. This has not caused any major issues as some are impromptu requests from a CG unit while others are just not input timely. The latter should be improved as we go forward.

High Profile Requests from Sector to the D11N

Open items from last report:

1. A request was made for PA support to generally assist Sector SF when needed. Perry Joiner is considering.
2. Prevention Dept is looking for assistance in developing a routine tracking system. We have held one meeting to determine extent and scope.

New items:

1. Requests have been coming in for CG support for Fleet Week and other PA events this spring. Please get your requests in to me – earlier the better.
2. Request from D11 South for one boat to assist in Lake Isabel fishing derby.

Electronic Emergency Notification System

As of this writing, only two divisions have 100% of their designated commanders registered on the system (Div-1 and Div-11). No Division has 100% completion of initial testing of system. In total, only 50% of designated commanders have registered. Less than 40% of the units have conducted an initial test. The foregoing renders this system essentially useless to us in an emergency or if we need to conduct a well-being assessment. Again, I have set up the system groups, have distributed our contingency plan and Everbridge instructions to all designated commanders and have extended an offer to train anyone who desires it. It has been suggested that perhaps, each Division Commander conduct a “Go to Meeting” training session with his/her flotilla commanders and I will gladly participate in these - the sooner the better.
