PV items of interest to talk about while making Visits:

**repeat of last month as this is such critical info to share with many emerging kayak and paddle sport shops across the USA*

HOT NEWS! The dangers to those operating Paddle Craft are rapidly gaining the attention of law enforcement as well as the USCG. Locally here on S.F. Bay, warnings are not given first by waterborne police patrols, only fines of over \$300 should Paddlers be found without required safety equipment such as tethers and some method of floatation. The USCG is also citing but not fining those missing these items. At this time, enforcement is spotty. Local kitesailer/windsurfer/paddle craft shops are adamant when ensuring their clients adhere to these safety standards. This points to heightened teaching of the basic safety standards we in the AUX teach. Rick Saber

Paddle Craft Safety is top priority. We Program Visitors have primary responsibility for getting word out on coming ABS courses, distribution of I.D. decals and integration with Vessel Examiners for face to face sharing of safety tips with this class of boater via application of VE cards on all pamphlet stands. IT IS OFFICIAL! CA will require anyone operating a powered boat to be in possession of a Boaters Card effective 1 JAN 2018, phased in with

New **ABS** (About Boating Safety) 8-hour courses given by Flotillas qualify new members for safe boating requirement following BQ (Basic Qualification). This ABS course also qualifies boaters needing mandated CA requirement for basic safety course starting in 2018. We PV members need to get this word out
